The Berlin Wall


In the early hours of the morning on 13 August 1961, Soviet and East German soldiers put barbed wire barriers across the streets in Berlin. Three days later, they began to replace the barbed wire with a concrete wall. When they had finished, West Berlin was surrounded by a wall that was 4 metres high and 11 kilometres long. It was overlooked by armed border guards in over 300 watchtowers, who made sure nobody crossed.
