# CREATIVE WRITING ACTIVITY: CREATE YOUR OWN CURSE

### WHO, WHAT, WHEN, WHERE, WHY, HOW?

WHO – Curses can be on locations, on objects or on people (or sometimes on entire families) – who or what is cursed?
WHAT – Some curses trap people together in darkness forever, some curses make sure families are always on the run. What does your curse do?
WHEN – Sometimes curses can be placed thousands of years ago, some in the modern world. When was the curse first enacted?
WHERE – Think about where you want the curse to take place – is it at a certain point in time or history, is it local to a specific town or country? Where does the curse take place?
WHY – Did the person who was cursed do something to offend an ancient witch or warlock? Is an object cursed because it is too powerful to be wielded by one person? Why was the curse enacted?
HOW – Curses can be always be broken (and in some cases their effects minimised). How does someone break the curse?

#### **ANSWERS:**

- 1. MUMMY. The Mummy's Curse, aka King Tutankhamun's Curse, is said to bring illness, bad luck and even death upon any who disturb the Mummy's tomb in Egypt.

According to folklore a coven of witches found out about Shakespeare using real spell incantations, so they put a curse on the play. The play has ever since suffered many disasters, like actors getting injured.



## DRAW YOUR 'MUST-TAKE' ITEMS:


Noah Bradley has a duffel bag filled with items he always takes with him when his family moves to a new home to escape the curse. Draw what you would take in your duffel bag.
