

With monsters in mind, here's one of my favourite poetry recipes.



FEATURE DESCRIPTION COLOUR **NUMBER** eyes fiery red Example:

Now, think of four -ing words that the eyes are doing:

glaring glowing looking Example: staring

Three red fiery eyes So, we have:

Staring, looking, glowing, glaring

Try saying it in a rhythm: Three – red – fiery – eyes

Staring – looking – glowing – glaring

Now think of different numbers, colours,

descriptions, features and what they may be doing.

There's only one rule — you can't repeat any word

at all. I usually find that four sets of two lines

works well.

Try writing about different types of monsters – scary, cute, funny, disgusting – and see which words work best for each particular

type.

Look at all the ideas and pick the best ones, find better words or

change the order – eg, my lines above could become:

Looking – staring – glowing – glaring
