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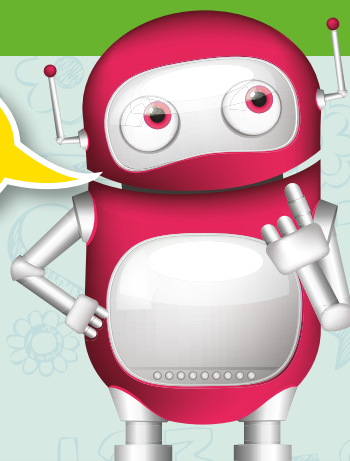

# Capital letters and full stops

## Recap

## Learn

Sentences start with a **capital letter** and end with a **full stop**.

Capital letters	A	B	C	D	E	F	G	H	I	J	K	L	M
Lower-case letters	a	b	c	d	e	f	g	h	i	j	k	l	m

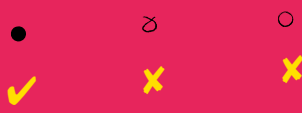
Capital letters	N	O	P	Q	R	S	T	U	V	W	X	Y	Z
Lower-case letters	n	o	p	q	r	s	t	u	v	w	x	y	z



**Tip**

A full stop shows the reader the sentence has ended.

A full stop is a small dot.

# Adding 'ing'

## Recap

A suffix is a letter or group of letters you add to the end of a word to change the meaning.

owl + **s** = owls



dish + **es** = dishes



## Learn

We can add the suffix **ing** to words.

jump + **ing** = jumping

I jump in puddles.  
I am jumping in puddles.



cook + **ing** = cooking

I cook lunch.  
I am cooking lunch.

draw + **ing** = drawing

I can draw a cat.  
I am drawing a cat.

play + **ing** = playing

I play tennis.  
I am playing tennis.
