- l duster

What you do:

- 1. First remove any mud or dust from each shoe.
- 2. Place the newspaper on the floor or on a table.
- 3. Place the shoes on the newspaper.
- 4. Dip one of the brushes into the tin of polish. Do not overload the brush.
