This is where I go to sleep. I'm the oldest so I get the big bed. My little sister sleeps in the half cot.


Master bedroom

I like this room because it is full of toys and games! Sometimes the governess visits and makes us do writing and arithmetic. We use slate and chalk to write down what we learn.


Bathroom
