


Blackberries

Squishy, soft, black berries growing on brambles in hedges, verges or in the woods.




Conkers

Split, brown, spiky cases with brown conkers inside, growing on horse chestnut trees




Holly berries

Soft, red berries growing on female holly bushes.




Hawthorn berries

Red, fleshy berries growing on hawthorn trees.




Ashseeds

Clusters of brown seeds with long wings growing on ash trees.




Beech nuts

Small, brown nuts growing inside brown husks on beech trees




Elderberries

Clusters of small black berries growing on elder trees.




Acorns
